

Here's the suggested phrasing to add to your recommendation in your acoustic report:

Alternate ventilation requirements.

Natural ventilation of the habitable rooms requires the doors and windows to be open. With the windows and doors open 20% of their capacity, the noise level inside the rooms that is generated by the external noise source should be less than 10dB above the internal noise criteria for the designated use of the room. Our tests indicate that this cannot be achieved for the following rooms

Therefore, an alternative method of ventilation is required for these areas, such as a ducted Air Conditioning system with a dedicated fresh air supply, or Silenceair Acoustic ventilators (www.silenceair.com).
