
- Locate the Silenceair module on the wall.
- Mark the location of the air inlet opening on the wall with a small pilot hole.
- Ensure the air inlet is in the desired location on the exterior panel.

• Offset the sarking and remove one brick to allow the air inlet weather louvre to be installed.






- Fix the Silenceair into position.
- Ensure correct alignment with the air inlet.
- It can be glued or screwed into position to the studs or the top hats.
- Seal around the edges of the Silenceair and the wall sheeting to ensure no sound can leak out around the unit.


 Once the interior plaster board lining is installed and painted the interior air out register can be fitted. 5

- From the inside, the Silenceair module is completely hidden in the wall cavity.
- Once the exterior brickwork is cleaned, install the colour coordinated exterior weather grille.
- Ensure the grille is installed the right way up.
